

CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

17 Street and 23 Avenue Widening Work

Roadwork has resumed. Our priority is to complete the work safely while maintaining access and mobility. Be aware of changing hazards when walking, cycling, or driving through the area. Pedestrians and cyclists, please consult the detour maps provided throughout the project to determine the safest, most efficient route to your destination and stay out of the construction site. Drivers, please follow construction signage and posted speed limits. As construction progresses, there may be changes that can disrupt your daily commutes. Please be aware and plan accordingly.

Our goal is to complete roadworks in 2024 and landscaping in 2025. We appreciate your patience as we complete new road and sidewalk connections. The expected impacts are:

17 Street and 23 Avenue

One lane of travel will be maintained in each direction throughout construction. ETS routes operate as normal throughout the project duration. Pedestrians and cyclists will continue to use the shared use path on the west side of 17 Street and the north side of 23 Avenue however there will be changes at the 17 Street and 23 Avenue intersection. Please respect construction signage and detours.

Meadows Rec Center, Elder Dr. Francis Whiskeyjack School

Access off 17 Street will remain open throughout construction.

Tamarack Commons

Access to 23 Avenue will remain open throughout construction, while the two accesses on 17 Street will have phased closures.

Meadowlands Baptist Church, Meadows Christian School

Accesses that were closed in 2023 will remain closed until fall 2024. Access from 23 Avenue will remain open throughout construction but will shift to allow for intersection reconstruction. A pedestrian access walkway will be adjacent to the vehicle access from 23 Avenue. Temporary pedestrian controls will be installed to improve visibility and safety.
